The West River Valley Regional Solid Waste District is required by Act 752 of 1991 to enact and enforce a licensing program for all haulers who collect or transport solid waste in our nine-county district. The purpose of this licensing program is to better manage and monitor the collection and transportation of solid waste by haulers in the District.

Please note that all vehicles used for collection must be registered and have an official 2020 West River Valley RSWMD sticker. Per Ark. Code Ann. § 8-6-722, failure to comply with all rules of the District may result in a revocation of hauler license, a misdemeanor charge, fines, and/or imprisonment.

A copy of the complete Rules & Regulations of the District may be obtained anytime by calling the District office or downloading from the District website at wrvsolidwaste.org

The deadline for hauler permits to be turned in to the District office is December 15, 2019.

4.) COLLECTION VEHICLE REGISTRATION - Attach a separate sheet if necessary.

Solid waste must be collected and transported so as to prevent public health hazards, environmental hazards, safety hazards, and nuisances and must be kept in sanitary condition. Collection and transportation equipment must be designed and constructed so as to be leak-proof (**No trailers**). The waste must be suitably enclosed or covered so as to prevent roadside littering, attraction of vectors or creation of other nuisances. Vehicles must either have an enclosed waste storage area or all waste must be completely covered by a tarp when the vehicle is traveling in excess of 25 miles per hour.

Please note that all vehicles used for collection must be registered and have an official 2019 West River Valley RSWMD sticker. Per Ark. Code Ann. § 8-6-722, failure to comply with all rules of the District may result in a misdemeanor charge, fines, and/or imprisonment.

9.) LICENSING ASSESSMENT FEE

The 2020 Solid Waste Hauler Licenses will run from January 1 through December 31, 2020. Each collection vehicle must be accounted for, be assessed by the District, and must have a sticker. Although each vehicle must be registered, the maximum fee assessment will be no more than \$500.00. The full year fees are as follows.

§ 9.06 Penalties

- (a) Failure to register under these regulations constitutes a misdemeanor under Ark. Code. Ann. § 8-6-722. Upon conviction the person shall be subject to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both imprisonment and fine. Additionally, failure to register may subject the hauler to administrative penalties of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and two (2) points for the first offense, and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and four (4) points for subsequent offenses. Each day or part of any day during which a violation is continued or repeated shall constitute a separate offense.
- (b) Failure to comply with any other part of this subchapter constitutes a misdemeanor under Ark. Code. Ann. § 8-6-722. Upon conviction the person shall be subject to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the first offense, five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for a second offense and one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for subsequent offenses, or both imprisonment and fine. Each day or part of any day during which a violation is continued or repeated shall constitute a separate offense.
- (c) Failure to collect trash in a sanitary manner, failure to provide services without good cause, failure to provide service when requested without good cause, failure to submit adequate trust fund fees under Section 9.08, or failing to properly dispose of wastes collected may subject the hauler to administrative penalties of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) and one (1) point for the first offense, and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and two (2) points for subsequent offenses.
- (d) Failure to display the registration sticker, failure to notify the District of additional trucks, failure to display the haulers name and telephone number on the sides of vehicles, or other administrative violations may subject the hauler to administrative penalties of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and one (1) point for the first offense, and not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) and two (2) points for subsequent offenses.
